Footnotes

TOUGHTRIX pulled hard early into the first turn, steadied, came out a bit across a rival's heels into the first turn triggering a chain reaction of interference, stalked leaders, three wide into the lane, challenged inside a drifting leader past the furlong marker, drew clear. CITY LOVER rank early when contesting the lead while well out in the course, dueled up the backstretch, headed, regained the advantage upper stretch, drifted out, no match late, held the place. ROBYNSCOUNTRYQUEEN forwardly placed, in some traffic late second turn, four wide into the lane, bothered slightly when the runner up drifted out past the furlong marker, finished up evenly, narrowly held the show. KE NAKO lacked speed, moved out and continued outside in the run up the backstretch, advanced four wide far turn, set down for the drive, finished willingly to miss the show. MAGIC DARE alternated up front while closest to the inside for six furlongs, weakened when the real running began at the head of the lane. LADY WOODEND settled off the pace, saved all the ground, moved a bit closer

late in the second turn, evenly through the lane in lacking a late kick. SAINT BREESY raced outside past the wire the first time, carried extremely wide into the first turn, continued back, improved position late with some belated interest out in the course. EYE BELONG TO ME back off the pace, moved a bit closer while five wide turning for home, flattened out. PRETTIESGIRLINTOWN behind the early leaders, bothered, forced out into the first turn when the winner steadied across a rival's heels, carried three foes very wide, settled in the run up the backstretch, had little left for the drive. DON'TMESSWITHVICKI cut off at the start, bothered, forced out very wide into the first turn, remained always back. GORUM broke out to cut off DON'TMESSWITHVICKI, forced out very wide into the first turn, nothing for drive.
