Footnotes

SUNDOWNROCKET pressured the leader off the inside, kindly handled in the run up the backstretch, engaged that same rival turning for home, long drive, proved narrowly best in a determined effort. GOODSPOT away well, showed the way from along the inside, responded when challenged by the winner, proved stubborn to the end. SPIT N WHITTLE outrun in the early going, moved closer while continuing along the inside into the far turn, shuffled back while lacking room inside late in that bend, got through and finished up willingly. REAL TRICK within striking distance in the second flight toward the inside, moved out a bit for the drive, lacked a winning response. BERRY TOWN void of speed, moved off the inside, raced four out to five wide turning for home, also lacked a serious closing response. KIKSLITTER settled off the pace, raced in some traffic late in the final turn, came up empty for the drive as well. SPEEDY GLIDE void of speed, bit closer second turn, lacked room in some traffic with a quarter to run, altered course out to be three wide, no response when clear. MAFASA'S IDOL tired in the drive. REMEMBER HOAGY four wide first turn, continued outside, four wide late in the second bend, tired.
