CORN DOG forwardly placed, continued to track the leaders up the backstretch and into the far turn toward the inside, eased out, put foe in tight turning for home, lost some momentum, regathered, closed with good courage to prove best. QUE PASO off the early pace, moved a bit closer along the inside second turn, raced in some traffic into the lane, challenged along the rail inside the furlong marker, outfinished. SNOOK broke alertly, set the pace just off the inside, weakened when headed late, saved the show. ANGELONMYSHOULDER (GB) within striking distance, four wide turning for home, went evenly to the wire. WILD SUNDAY (GB) off the pace, saved ground into the far turn, shuffled back in tight along the rail, went evenly through the stretch. WAJIR ON ME unprepared for the start, raced back, fanned six wide into the lane, failed to rally. THEATRICAL'S HALO void of speed, fanned five wide while between rivals out of the final turn, remained back through the lane. MAE B TODAY prompted the pace off the inside, was beginning to tire when put in tight turning for home, continued to fade down the straight.
