OLD ROME broke sharp, got clear early, dueled through a lively half mile, shook clear again when straightened for home and stayed on to the wire. GLORIOUS STRIKE back off the pace and the inside, came three wide when being asked along exiting the final turn, finished willingly to earn the place. SOVIET AFLEET chased the winner early, pushed that rival through a quick four furlongs, could not keep up in the drive, no match for the runner up, narrowly saved the show. WANDO VENTURE void of early foot, three wide into the straight, found his best stride too late. CHAD BE GLAD forwardly placed early along the inside, weakened. GRETSKY back off the pace, raced in some traffic stretch, failed to respond when asked. COUSIN KEVIN four wide through the first turn, raced forwardly for five furlongs, had little left for the drive. BEE TREE was never involved. TENURE faded through the stretch.
