### Footnotes

STRATEGIC GAME never far back on the outside, moved to challenge into the turn while four wide, dueled through the stretch, proved best under firm handling. MOON BOOGIE forwardly placed, vied between foes into the turn, dueled out of the turn inside the winner, equal terms with that rival past the furlong marker, outkicked in the late going. CALHOUN STONEWALL vied early off the rail, dropped to the inside turn, no match for the top two, held the show. WESTERN SUN stumbled at the start then was bothered, trailed out of the chute, three wide and between foes out of the turn, gaining for the show late. INQUISIT lacked speed, came four wide out of the turn, went evenly the final furlong. IRISHMAN ducked out at the start to bother outer rivals, moved up steadily the opening quarter to contest the issue early, faded through the stretch. RIP'EM DIAMOND bothered at the start, lacked speed, wide out of the turn, bit greenly in the drive.
