EL GATO GRANDE broke alertly, showed the way into the first turn just off the inside, rated while continuing to set the pace, shook well clear, held the runner up safe late. MONARCHOS BOY forwardly placed inside, continued to race within striking distance middle half while saving ground, angled out three wide exiting the final turn, set down, getting to the winner late. MISTER LUKE void of early foot, improved position considerably by saving ground into the lane, finished up best of the rest. CLUB off the early pace, moved up to force the issue three wide the middle half, weakened in the drive. HE'S PERFECT well off the pace for six furlongs, fanned out to be six wide turning for home, managed little in the way of a rally. MADE IN OKLAHOMA came out a bit and was four wide through the first turn when off the pace, continued outside, four wide turning for home, also failed to fire off a rally. TUNNELA WAY four wide when off the pace into the first turn, remained back, floated out to be seven wide into the stretch, remained back. DORVAN prompted the pace off the inside, gave way in the drive. BEST INTENT last to leave, never close, fell further back, distanced.
