MISSY MOO broke alertly, soon got clear and angled quickly to the inside, larger lead turn into the stretch, maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire while being kept to task. DESTINY'S PORT off slowly, moved outside, four out to five wide through the turn, widest in the drive, finished up willingly. SUNNY LEESTOWN went one paced throughout, raced a bit greenly down the lane, finished up best of the rest. RUN AND COLLECT raced in the two path most of the way, made little impact. GIRLLCANRUN lost footing at the start, four wide through the turn, managed little in the way of any late gain. TIDAL PLAIN off slowly, moved up to race in the second flight while outside, came up empty for the drive. LEESTOWN SILVER chased the winner for three furlongs closest to the inside, gave way in the drive. ANITA'S JOY trailed most of the way in showing little. PORTO CAT retreated while three wide.
