Footnotes

OBREGON with the pace leaving the chute, fell back a bit off the leaders backstretch, ranged up three wide to challenge midway on the turn while between foes, long stretch duel, proved best under firm handling. SENT hesitated at the start to spot the field a couple of lengths, rushed up the rail to be with the leaders before a quarter, vied through the turn while continuing closest to the inside, stretch duel, proved stubborn to the end. ANGEL FISH raced off the early pace, moved up to challenge with the winner midway on the turn while outside that foe, lost some ground exiting the bend, could not get back to the top two late. LOQUACITY lacked early foot, remained well back in the turn while saving ground, improved position inside of foes stretch. SERRALADA evenly paced throughout, five wide late in the turn. LU LU WILDCAT vied up front off the inside, steadied in tight quarters midway on the turn, faded. DEL NORTE AFFAIR trailed most of the way in showing little. POINT GRACE never menaced while three wide.
