**Footnotes**

NOAH'S TRAVELER close from the start, took over three wide in the turn, got clear in the drive, kept to task. SOFT SHOE forwardly placed in traffic toward the inside, moved out to be four wide midway on the turn, set down for the drive, finished up willingly to be clear for the place. EXPECT A FLYER off the pace, raced four wide through much of the turn when moving a bit closer, proved no match for the top two the final furlong. MAJESTIC SPIRIT vied early along the inside, fell back in the turn, evenly in the drive. NOT SO WILD steadied early, moved closer three wide through the turn, flattened out in the drive. JOHN'S BROWN BEAR lacked speed, was five wide out of the turn, improved upper stretch then also failed to follow through the final furlong. THE UNIT in some traffic out of the gate, checked up repeatedly in tight quarters the opening furlong, not a threat in the drive. BUCK'S BILL devoid of early foot, got to the inside, passed some tiring foes into the stretch while continuing inside. GUITAR PLAYER was never a threat three wide. YOUR HOST showed some brief speed between foes, finished early. GUILTYBYASSOCIATION also raced with the early pace, stopped from between foes.
