Footnotes

HIGH HAND behind the early leaders while off the inside, split foes when challenging entering the stretch, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, larger lead late, just held the runner up safe in the final strides. GREAT AND TOUGH off the pace, moved closer toward the inside late in the turn and into the stretch, altered course sharply past the furlong marker for room, set down, finished willingly to miss. HUNTER VISION raced outside and back under confident handling, came five wide into the lane, bothered slightly by the runner up when that once changed course a furlong out, could not match that foe late, up for the show. BAND OF LOVE void of speed, came three wide out of the turn while remaining back, moved out to be widest for the drive, finished willingly while too late. DOALITTLELATER closest to the leaders, came four wide into the stretch, challenged outside the winner soon after, faltered in the late going. SILVERKNOWES off a step slow, trailed early, showed some belated interest while not a serious threat. CAFE SKITDADDEL dueled up front off the inside, weakened in the drive. WHAT A BROTHER lacked a response in the drive. TICKET TO VEGAS was never a factor. MC'S PERFECTPOISON alternated up front closest to the inside for a half and stopped. FRASRHASLFTTHEBLGD off slowly, was finished early.
