WAKKIANO pressured the pace off the inside, dueled the middle half, put the other speed away a furlong out, kicked clear. PRIETO JOLIE last away, devoid of any kind of early foot, six wide out of the final turn, finished full of run and was clear for the place. TIZ A SCHOLAR settled early, four wide into the lane, ranged up closer four wide turning for home, closest to the winner late, caught final strides for the place. COUPLE OF HOURS pulled hard early inside, continued within striking distance, came up empty in the late going. KNOCK turned in an even effort in lacking a late bid. MARION PONDEROSA was never a factor. SMILE FOR UR I D showed the way early, dueled up front closest to the inside, stopped in the drive. ACK CRAFTY had nothing for the drive.
