SHEEZ LEAVIN stalked the pace on the outside under kind handling, four wide out of the turn, roused, finished with good energy to be clear late. DOLLY BONZ bumped, in tight at the start, raced off the pace, three wide into the lane, no match winner, clear for the place. TIGER EYED in tight at the start, trailed out in the strip, came six wide into the lane, lodged a minor rally down the middle of the strip to get the show. POLLYPRISSYPANTS evenly paced toward the inside, in some traffic into the stretch, improved slightly when clear, never dangerous. SOXIE'S GOLD TOUR brushed at the start, five wide into the stretch, failed to rally. WILL BE A STORM dueled up front off the inside, gave way in the drive. PRETTY NEAT alternated up front closest to the inside, stopped.
