KAT'S COURT outrun in the early going, came three wide into the stretch, slight brush, roused, finished up willingly to prove best. BUTTER BROWN lacked speed early inside, moved out, four wide and outside the winner turning for home, slight brush with that rival, outkicked to the wire. LA PIANO MAN forwardly placed behind the leaders, two path late turn, dropped inside, challenged along the rail midstretch, not enough for the top two late. ELI'S GOLD pressured the early leader from the outside, dueled late in the turn and into the lane, continued to vie past the furlong marker while between rivals, weakened late. REDSUGAR away in good order, set the early pace, dueled late in the turn, weakened in the drive. C P IMPROVISE a bit slow in leaving, trailed early, never menaced. GEOTZ DISASTER void of speed, five wide late in the turn, remained back. LEESTOWN HERO forwardly placed in the early going, began a steady retreat before a half.
