MORE THAN TRICKY lacked speed, staged a modest rally while between foes in the drive, up for the show. SERVICE HAWK void of early foot, came four wide into the lane, did not have enough for a show. MEME'S BOY set the early pace, pressed, weakened. DOUBLE AGAIN five wide turning for home, no late kick. CLAUDIA'S FORUM fell back, no rally. SWEETENING had nothing for the drive.
