**Footnotes**

POPCORN SUNSET forwardly placed while four wide into the first turn, dueled into and through the second bend, gained a clear advantage into the stretch, drew out while being kept to task. BREONS GOLD void of early foot, advanced four wide into contention in the final turn, no match for the winner the final furlong, clearly second best. QUEEN OF BROADWAY settled off the early pace, also improved position while four wide in the second turn, finished up best of the rest. MISS RED SOLDIER off the pace, moved inside to save some ground, shuffled back in some traffic late on the backstretch, remained inside, improved position through the lane. LEESTOWN SILVER bothered slightly at the start, recovered to show the way into and through the first turn, dueled with the winner inside that foe through the final turn, weakened in the drive. PREDESTINED RUNNER broke out, pressured the early pace, also weakened in the drive. COMBAT'S LOVE last away, trailed most of the way and was never a factor. FATHER'S DREAM pressured the pace for a half and gave way.
