INTRACTABLE unhurried early, began a steady advance three wide after a half, challenged nearing the furlong marker, proved best under firm handling. MS. DOWDEN stalked the early pace, sudden move to garner the advantage far turn, showed the way into the stretch, could not contain the winner. BEST FOOT FORWARD lacked speed, began to rally through traffic late in the second turn, finished willingly toward the inside late. HALLIE CAT settled off the pace, advanced four wide into and through upper stretch, flattened out a bit in the late going to finish evenly. TAP TAP TAP within striking distance for three quarters, came up empty for the drive. HUMBLE BILLIE made little impact off the inside. BEERBELLYS SISTER void of early foot, passed tiring foes down the lane. LITTLE SHON steadied past the wire the first time, again onto the backstretch, checked late on the backstretch, finished. OBLIGATORY never menaced. TIFF'S BONZAI raced outside and failed to fire. SONG OF THE HAWK pressed the early pace and stopped. EXPECT ROSES set the early pace and also stopped.
