EASY FROM THE GATE cleared to the inside soon after the start, set the pace, responded when challenged by the winner, could not match that foe late, gamely held the the place. SMITTY'S MOONSHINE one paced throughout while saving all the ground, missed the place. K D'S BIG MAC in a bit tight at the start, went evenly in lacking a closing response. HIGH HAND off the pace, raced in some traffic turning into the stretch, came up empty when clear. ZARB'S WHIRL last to leave, trailed throughout in showing little.
