Footnotes

SASSY MAVERICK four wide when off the pace in the first turn, began a steady gain outside, bid, dueled through upper stretch, pulled away late under firm handling. MANDATED RULER last away, angled in while dropping well back, began to advance after five furlongs, came three wide into the lane, angled out slightly, rallied for the place. SILVER NICKEL forwardly placed, continued within striking distance the middle half, moved to challenge three wide into the far turn, took over, raced on equal terms with the winner when that one came alongside late in that bend, weakened final furlong, caught for the place. SHOEFLY SHOEFLY settled off the pace, came four wide out of the final turn, went evenly through the lane in lacking a closing response. HEY PODZ also came up empty for the drive. STATEHOOD set the pace, got briefly clear midway up the backstretch, faltered when headed in the far turn. DARK TUNNEL closest to the leader for a half, challenge after five furlongs between rivals, weakened soon after. S P WARRIOR five wide early in the first turn, fell back to trail, dull effort.
