RUN OVER ME RADE outrun in the early going, roused late in the turn, came four wide out of the turn, closed with good resolve down the center of the strip to be in time. LORI'S DREAM vied up front along the inside, shook clear of the other speed in upper stretch, could not contain the winner. COCOA MAX a bit slow in leaving, trailed early as a result, came out of the turn off the inside, late run through traffic to earn the show. HONOUR ROCKET settled off the pace and the inside, came five wide into the lane, improved position but did not have enough for the show while well wide at the line. TALE OF A SAINT was never dangerous. TIMELY MINARDI bobbed slightly at the start, recovered to vie between rivals for a half and began to weaken. POLY SAUCE with the pace for four furlongs while three wide, backed up in the drive. LEEISIANA BLUES was outrun while racing wide.
