MISS LADY ELLEN dueled up front past the wire the first time, got clear before a half, continued to hold a daylight advantage past the furlong marker, drew out, driving. RIXA MARIE outrun in the early going, moved closer the middle half, angled out then back in turning for home, lodged a mild, brief rail bid a furlong out, no match to the wire, clearly second best. DO YOU LIKE ME NOW in the second flight, moved a bit closer three wide and outside the runner up late in the second turn, flattened out, lasted for the show. FOURTEENGUNSALUTE lacked speed, make a modest advance three wide late in the final turn, also failed to sustain that effort in the drive. ABAMA LIGHT forwardly placed in the early going, fell back, failed to seriously threaten. HICKS HONEY last to leave, trailed most of the way, never a threat. NEW GIRL dueled early outside the winner, chased that one up the backstretch, faded while along the inside second turn.
