M DICATION a bit fractious in the gate, broke alertly, narrowly showed the way inside, headed briefly late in the turn, regained the advantage, drew off in the drive, ridden out. TOO DIM stumbled at the start, lacked early foot, came five wide out of the turn, rallied midtrack for the place, no match for the winner, all out to hold the second spot late. HOT FOOT HEAT broke in and slowly, raced well back early, wide through the turn, belated energy out in the strip, getting to the runner up. HURRICANE BLUFF within striking distance early, had little for the drive. RED PRODUCTION forwardly placed early outside, weakened while in some traffic midstretch. BOSTON SALT vied up front early while between rivals, dueled through the turn, held a small advantage briefly midway on the bend, gave way in the drive. BLUFFALATTA was never a threat. GO 'ON NOW was finished early.
