**Footnotes**

SISTER SIP lacked early foot, worked way to the outside when advancing turn, came six wide into the turn, closed with good resolve to be in time. MY COUSINS AND ME off the early pace while well off the rail, bit closer four wide into the turn, took over on the outside a quarter mile out, well clear, caught. SAHANA STAR void of early foot in trailing, saved some ground through the turn, steered to the far outside upper stretch, finished up willingly to be closing the gap on the top two late. WAR BONNET forwardly placed, enjoyed a good trip along the inside into the stretch, lacked a winning response. BRICK BRACK lacked speed after breaking a step slow, improved position a bit while in some traffic late in the turn, failed to muster a serious late response when clear for the drive. CADDO settled off the pace, came five wide out of the turn, also went evenly through the lane. SNOW FACTOR off the pace, came in the two path into the lane, encountered some traffic a furlong out, no late rally. INDIAN RIVER DOLL wide, not a threat. LOUISIANA ANGEL sprinted out to a long lead leaving the chute, showed the way into the turn, began to weaken then gave way when headed by the runner up with a quarter remaining. T'S DREAM forwardly placed after a slight bobble at the start, steadied in some tight quarters inside the runner up when moving closer midway on the turn, gave way in the drive. MANDY ON BROADWAY steadily retreated after a quarter.
