RYDER RIVER outrun in the early going, moved closer in the two path late second turn, traffic, split foes inside the furlong marker, drifted late, got up. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF WITH ATTITUDE AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. FASEAUX settled off the pace, came five wide into the lane, finished up willingly to be clear for the place. CHA CHA RIOS sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace, responded when challenged, could not match the top two late, saved the show while continuing inside. WITH ATTITUDE within chased the leader, briefly challenged that foe nearing the furlong grounds, flattened out, was going evenly when steadied late. HULA PIE within striking distance, lost some position upper stretch, continued in some traffic past the furlong marker, also was going evenly at the e3nd. HIGHER ED forwardly, little left final furlong. MAC FROM DAKOTA last away, raced back, was never dangerous. BLUEZY trailed, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a threat. DIXIE DOT RUN remained always back. FRANCHISE MAKER four wide through the first turn, stopped, eased stretch, walked off.
