Footnotes

Y'S BEAU allowed to settle early, raced in the second flight in the run up the backstretch, challenged on the outside in the second turn, well clear midstretch, enough left to hold the runner up safe late. POINT MINISTER lacked early foot, advanced into contention four wide late in the second turn, steadily getting to the winner late. KOBE DOO evenly paced much of the way, saved some ground in the second turn, split foes drive, up for show. JO'S THUNDER broke sharp, allowed the pace to go, second group inside, boxed in the far turn inside the winner, prominent until late, weakened. CHEROKEE LANDING lacked a late kick while off the inside. FIEND A BIT off slow, improved position slightly while never a threat. STUDLEEBOOM dueled off the inside, gave way in the drive. PRESIDENTE D'ORO alternated up front closest to the inside, also faltered when the real running start. DR. PARTEE veered in just after the start, was always outrun.
