Footnotes

CAMP BRET stalked the pace just off the inside, advanced into the lane to challenge, dueled past the furlong marker, fully extended. BLAZING GIBSON away in good order, dueled into and through much of the turn, responded when the winner challenged in upper straight, gave ground grudgingly to that foe. JUST EXPECTATIONS off the pace, angled out to be four wide turning for home, finished up willingly while unable to do much with the top two late. SPOOKS E Z well off the early pace, saved ground through the turn, staged a mild rally while continuing up the inside. PUNK'S UNCLE slight steady at the start to be last away, continued back early, improved through the turn and into the lane off the inside, flattened out a bit in the late going. DOCTOR LA behind the leaders off the inside, came five wide when asked out of the turn, failed to rally. SENOR MILAGRO was never a threat while racing out in the course. TAYLOR TIME vied up front outside the runner up, gave way suddenly entering the stretch, eased up past the furlong marker, walked off the course, vanned off main track.
