FORGET THE WEATHER outrun in the early going outside, dropped toward the inside far turn, saved ground into the stretch, angled out late when rallying smartly and continued full of run to the wire to win going away. WHAT AN HONOR vied up front early closest to the inside, disposed of the other speed to be well clear stretch, could not contain the winner. ENVOY'S RUNNING off a bit slow, trailed early, moved out, came five wide out of the final turn, rallied while widest and was up late for the show. DADDY'S MIRACLE evenly paced off the inside, moved a bit closer turning for home, was outkicked for the show. RUNNING SHOES went evenly off the inside. LOST MY HALO four wide into and through the turn, tired in the drive. YOU GOING LET'S GO dueled up front outside the runner up for less than three furlongs and began to give way. LITTLE SANTAYA was through early.
