OUR FINAL CHANCE in the second group toward the inside early, steadied slightly and moved out to avoid a stricken foe early in the turn, advanced into lane, bid, wore down leader under steady handling. SIMON RIDGE forwardly placed while outside, moved on the leader late in the turn, engaged that foe and took over from the outside, responded when challenged by the winner soon after, gave ground grudgingly to that rival. JEFF void of early foot, split foes out of the turn when beginning to advance, found best stride too late. NOBLE ALEX saved ground to no avail. SOUPER EX pressed the early leader, inherited the advantage when that foe gave way suddenly early in the turn, gave way in turn when headed by the runner up entering the stretch. RARE SONG lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn, failed to rally. SKINT BACK had nothing for the drive. TOOLBOX broke sharp, gave way suddenly along the inside early in the turn, pulled up upper stretch, vanned off.
