ZEALUNAR broke out but alertly, set all the pace toward, but not on the inside, increased advantage drive, kept to task. CLASSIC KEY BRIDGE chased the winner, pressured the pace the middle half, proved no match for the winner in the drive, clearly second best. MISS MATTY G lacked early foot, raced three wide much of the way, along for the show while no match for the top two. EUPHRATES RIVER raced forwardly and outside for six furlongs, gave way. DARING TIMES had nothing for the drive. WANDASLITTLEANGEL was finished early, well beaten.
