PERTINENT outrun in the early going, began to advance when asked second turn, came on the outside and finished up full of run to win going away. CHIEF GONE WEST forwardly placed, pressured the pace four wide into the far turn, challenged and showed the way past the furlong marker, no match for the winner. ALMO prompted the pace three wide, gained a narrow advantage in the second turn, could not maintain that lead in the drive. LUMBERJACK CAT settled off the early pace, got closest late in the second turn, lacked a further response. CARRY THE LOAN fell back while four wide in the first turn, trailed in the run up the backstretch, four wide again exiting the final bend, improved position. IMATITANTOO was not a factor. ANASHEED CLASS last away, outrun. VEGAS STORM pressed the pace for five furlongs and stopped. FORTUNE HALL narrowly set the pace, also stopped in the second turn, distanced stretch.
