Footnotes

LOW PLACES dueled up front closest to but not on the rail, disposed of the other speed midway on the second turn, shrugged off a bid from another foe turning for home, got clear then had enough left to hold the runner up comfortably safe in the late going. FIEND A BIT allowed the pace to go early, saved ground, continued along the inside into the lane, switched to the outside past the furlong marker, slowly getting to the winner late. EMPTY PAGES bobbed and broke out at the start, recovered to race closest to the two leaders while off the inside, ranged up to briefly challenge the winner outside that foe turning for home, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. I'M GOOD TO GO last to leave, trailed most of the way, never dangerous. SULTRY CROOK bothered slightly at the start when EMPTY PAGES broke out, moved up to duel outside the winner, stopped second turn.
