DIXIE TREE sprinted clear just after the start, set the all the pace inside, never threatened, won ridden out. NOBLE TEXAS last to leave, advanced up the rail, continued to save ground in the turn, angled out for the drive, finished willingly to be clear for the place. CAMSDANCER closest to the winner most of the way, weakened, caught for the place. SECURE LINE evenly paced throughout, lacked a late kick. PROSPECTOR'S ROAD broke through the gate prior to the start, ran off a sixteenth, made little impact. LOT O' BUG lacked a rally. FUTURE VISION fractious when PROSPECTOR'S ROAD broke through the gate prior to the start, reared, also broke through, immediately caught and reloaded, faded. GOLDATWORK trailed throughout while racing in the three path.
