JETTIN CASCADE close early from along the inside, moved out in the turn, collared the leader from the outside entering the stretch, put that foe away to be clear, held the runner up safe late. HIT THAT STRIKE angled to the inside not long after the start, continued to save ground turn, rallied up the rail in the drive to be slowly getting to the winner late. NATIVE DAZZLER off the pace and the inside, four wide out of the turn, staged a mild rally to be also getting to the winner late. FRANS LUCKY ONE within striking distance, three wide through the turn, lacked a winning response in the drive. FOODO'S BOY used early to clear, garnered a larger advantage in the turn, faltered when confronted entering the stretch. VAMOOSE VOMANOSO off a step slow, trailed much of the way, picked off a couple of tiring rivals late well after the issue had been decided. BEECHCREEKBOY remained back throughout. SAMMY DA DICTATOR broke on top, fell back off the pace, faded in the drive.
