Footnotes

NETTIE HUGHES closest to the early leader, engaged that foe from the outside before a half, disposed of the other speed midway on the second turn, held the runner up safe the length of the stretch under steady handling. LOUISIANA SHINE slight bobble at the start, raced off the pace, brief steady in some traffic first turn, moved out, advanced, challenged the winner turning for home, second best. TEARS IN MY EYES devoid of speed, three wide into the lane, staged a mild rally to be up for the show, no match for the top two. UP TOWN MARY within striking distance off the inside, came four wide into the lane, lacked a late kick, caught late for the show. STORM TRIP four wide in the first turn when off the pace, four wide again late in the second turn, slight bother entering the stretch, also failed to rally. ROBERT'S BEAUTY remained back and was never a threat. ST SOUTHERN BELLE cleared toward the inside, set the pace until headed by the winner second turn, stopped.
