STRING KING took command soon after the start, rated through a moderate pace toward the inside, stayed clear through the stretch while being kept to task. GO TIGER JACK allowed the pace to go early, ranged up with a three wide advance into contention late in the final turn, closest to the winner when straightened for home, no late gain on that foe, clearly second best. THE MALLARD MAN void of speed, three wide and in some traffic late in the second turn, up late for the show while not a threat to the top two. LEE'S SPIRIT last away, trailed early, four wide into the stretch, outfinished for the show spot. DAKOTA GYPSY within striking distance inside, continued to save ground into the stretch, lacked a late response. ACES N KINGS forwardly placed for six furlongs, had little left for the drive. ROAD HAWK closest to the winner for six furlongs, gave way in the drive.
