Footnotes

HAPPY PATSY forwardly placed toward the inside, rated onto the backstretch, moved up to lodge an inside bid into the far turn, fell back late in the bend, moved out for the drive, came again late to be clear at the wire. A. P. NOTEBOOK lacked early foot, steered out a bit for the drive, finished willingly to be clear for the place. DESSERT DIVA took control soon after the start, set the pace off the inside, allowed the winner the rail with less than a half mile remaining, shook clear late in the final turn, continued to hold a sizable advantage past the furlong marker, fell apart late. SNUCKOUT TWICE broke a step slow, trailed well back, continued to be outrun late in the final turn, found best stride too late up the rail. LOUISIANA MAGIC off slowly, moved up to race in mid pack before a half, came up empty for the drive. MY HONKYTONK ANGEL was never dangerous. JOYFUL PRAISE settled off the pace and the inside, came five wide out of the final turn and tired. SOUTHERN SADIE chased the leader for five furlongs off the rail, stopped in the drive.
