NANIE'S DINNER rated kindly while clear through soft fractions, won with something left. TAFFY prompted the winner, lodged a mild bid outside that one late in the second turn, no match drive. SARAH LANE'S OATES outrun through some slow early splits, saved ground and was along for the show up the rail. BLACK TIE QUEEN within striking distance toward the inside, went evenly through the straight. SOUTHERN IVY stout restraint early, no late bid. DANZIGCA broke in the air, remained back. LILLET trailed behind that slow pace and failed to muster much of a rally. SOLO ATTACK gave way after six furlongs off the inside.
