OUR SASSY TEN with the pace from the start, vied three wide through the turn and into the lane, set down, began to draw away nearing the furlong grounds. YURA DAISY IF U DO also vied from the start, between foes, no match winner, clear of the 5rest. SHEEZ LEAVIN in the second group while five wide into the turn, continued five wide into the lane, roused, could do little with the top two the final furlong. PRINCESS OF PEACE fell back at the start, continued to trail through the turn, showed some belated interest after the issue had been decided. ISLAND BLUFF lacked speed, roused while six wide out of the turn, went evenly in the late going while remaining well out in the strip. GALLANTLY in the second group, moved a bit closer while four wide late in the turn, had nothing for the drive. MISS BELL STAR set or forced the pace for a half along the inside and stopped.
