INTINCTION away well, soon clear, continued to set pace turn, responded when challenged by the runner up from the inside upper stretch, dug in late to gain the nod. HELICOPTER ACE off a step slow, moved up, shuffled back a bit when boxed in through much of the turn, got through, challenged inside the winner, missed. IMAHEMI off the pace toward the inside, behind the runner up into the lane, attempted to split foes inside the furlong marker, lacked the necessary response, angled out late, could not get to the top two. LAKE POMEROY off the pace and the inside, asked along in some traffic late turn, steered out, roused, lacked a winning kick late. OUR DIVA FACTOR four wide through the turn when within striking distance, came up empty for the drive. CLUB bobbled at the start, raced back throughout, made little impact. HEZA CHAMP five wide through the turn, had little left for the drive. BRIAN'S BULLET pressured the pace for three furlongs and gave way. THE DEMON CHILD was not involved. IN A COUNTRY BOY broke in and slow, trailed, fell further and further back, distanced.
