### Footnotes

EVERSTRAIGHT broke in good order, vied early between foes, dueled into and through the turn closest to the inside, long drive, headed a furlong out, battled back to edge clear late in game fashion. CHIQUITO broke on top, alternated up front while off the inside, held the advantage midstretch, outfinished late. I LIKE HOPE within striking distance off the inside, four wide into the lane when closest, lacked late punch, narrowly gained the show while between rivals. PRINCE ALEX pushed in and bothered at the start, moved up to race in the second flight while between rivals late on the backstretch, three wide and in traffic entering the stretch, also lacked a serious late kick, missed the show. TOOTHPICKSANDWATER lacked early foot, moved out to be five wide out of the turn, not enough late for the show while widest of the second flight. JOE'S GOTTA GO broke to the inside to bother PRINCE ALEX, raced with the early pace briefly closest to the inside, shuffled back into the turn, did not menace stretch. PASTEL STREAM broke a step slow, trailed throughout.
