QUEEN EVE'S IMP took command soon after the start, shrugged of bids from two rivals turning for home and drew clear once again. SOME RUNAWAY, unhurried for six furlongs, staged a mild rally and finished best of the others. ZARB'S PET, forwardly placed, challenged from the outside in the second turn then hung in the drive. SILVER ON SILVER went evenly toward the inside. STRINDBERGS LAUREL lacked a late response while drifting out late. TARRATINE lodged a bid from between rivals in the second turn then faltered in the drive. GENE'S GOLD never menaced. SENOR LARRY was outrun well off the inside. HAVANA LUKE trailed.
