PIOUS PREACHER behind the pace in hand and toward the inside, continued to race in the second flight into the lane, asked, split foes, proved best. TICFAW outrun in the early going outside, moved closer while continuing out in the course far turn, five wide into the straight, moved out a bit further, late bid, outfinished. THE MALLARD MAN broke out, straightened to race forwardly out in the course, four wide second turn when forcing the issue, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, not enough late. EXCLUSIVE ALLIANCE forwardly placed, joined the fray before a half, continued to vie into the lane, also was found lacking late. ELECTRIC ALPHABET broke in, narrowly set the pace, faltered into the lane. DOCTOR BRASCH off the pace, moved a bit closer in traffic second turn, lacked a further bid. LUMBERJACK CAT well back off the early pace, five wide late in the final turn, failed to rally when called on. ONLY MAN IN TOWN pinched back at the start, was never close. HOLD FAST pressed the leader four five furlongs and stopped.
