BACK STREET HEAT settled, in the second flight into the far turn, came three wide into the lane, bid, wore down leader under firm handling. MIZZEN MAZE broke on top, soon got well clear, continued to set the pace far turn, responded, gave ground grudgingly to the winner, held the place. SUMMANUS off the pace, came three wide into the stretch, rallied through traffic, flattened out a bit in the final furlong. ROUTE lacked speed, middle move outside, 5w turning for home, also hung a bit in the final furlong. LIMO KID in the second group toward the inside, saved ground through the final turn, went evenly in the drive. INVISIBLE FORCE last away, trailed well back, four wide out of the final turn, picked off a couple of tiring foes while never a threat. THUNDER BRITCHES chased the runner up for six furlongs off the inside and began to tire. PLAYGROUND failed to respond in the drive. SIERRA MAESTRA forwardly placed, steadied, fell back 7/16.
