QUEENS WALK forwardly placed from the start, pressured the pace four wide through the turn, lost some ground to the leader into the lane, engaged that one midstretch, long drive, best. TANGERINE DREAM pressured the pace while three wide into the turn, between rivals into the lane, finished willingly to miss while inside the winner. TERRE NOIRE away well showed the way inside, continued to lead into the lane, could not contain the top two, saved the show. MEREDITH'S REBEL off the pace while well out in the strip, came five wide into the stretch, lacked a winning kick midtrack. SOUTHERN ART lacked early foot, moved a bit closer while four wide late in the turn, finished up evenly. LEESTOWN GIRL off the pace, swung out to be five wide out of the turn, came up empty for the drive. PEN CITY went one paced throughout while saving ground. MISS LILY MAE void of early foot, six wide turning for home, passed tiring foes while not a threat. CALIENTE'S ROSE never a threat while also picking off a few faltering rivals. ERLTON QUEEN bobbled at the start,

remained back. CHARGRAY steadily faded. TOASTIES CHOICE flashed brief speed off the inside and stopped.
