### Footnotes

PEACE RUMOR off the pace, rallied up the rail, challenged inside the furlong marker, got clear then held the runner up safe late. LAC VALENTINE stumbled just after the start, fell well back, roused for the drive, finished strongly, split foes late, gaining. WESTERN PINE with the early pace, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, allowed the winner the rail, could not contain that foe or the runner up, salvaged the show. MACHO TIME forwardly placed outside, came four wide out of the turn, managed little in the way of a rally. DOUBLEDOWNANDHIT five wide exiting the turn, also lacked a bid. PROMT RESPONSE dueled up front while off the inside, gave way in the drive. CATO never a threat.
