UP AND OUT OF SITE away in good order, set the pace while in hand, continued to rate in the run up the backstretch, responded when challenged and briefly headed upper stretch, edged away late under firm handling. THE MALLARD MAN settled behind the winner inside, moved out for the drive, set down, lacked a winning kick. GRETSKY prompted the pace, moved closer to challenge the winner outside that rival into the lane, briefly put a head in front nearing the furlong grounds, failed to follow through. WILLIST off the pace and the inside, came four wide out of the final turn, went evenly to the wire. OH MIGHTY DOLLAR lacked speed, dropped to the inside entering the stretch, improved a bit while never a serious threat. SMART DRESSED GUY five side into the first turn, fell back to trail, five wide again late in the second bend, managed little in the way of a rally. GOWDEN MILE lacked speed, four wide turning for home, empty. SPECIAL TREE pressured the pace outside the winner for six furlongs and gave way. HALLOWED MISSIONS was finished early.
