WINNING FEVER away best of ally, quickly clear, large advantage into the stretch, could not contain the winner, narrowly held the place. BAG OF STARS lacked speed, moved out a bit for the drive, finished well to miss the place. MIDNIGHT JUDGE closest to the runner up much of the way, had little late punch. WELL GO THEN improved slightly while not a threat. RANDI BRANDY wide trip, lacked a bid. FORTY DOLLS remained always back. QUITE SPENDER stopped in the drive.
