MALLARD'S BRO outrun in the early going while saving ground, moved closer into the far turn, angled out three wide for room late in the final turn, bid, strongly clear. FLASHY SPLASHY mid pack early, fell back the middle half, raced in traffic when advancing into the straight, finished willingly to be clear for the place, no match winner. BETIZZED forwardly placed into the first turn, moved up to vie before a half, narrowly showed the way into the lane, offered little resistance to the winner, also failed to contain the runner up, saved the show. ALL FOR GOLD pulled early while well off the pace and the inside, advanced 4w far turn, carried five wide into the stretch, staged a mild rally to improve a bit late. SWAY SPLENDID four wide when mid pack into and through the first turn, continued on the outside, four wide again late in the final turn, went evenly in the drive. FETCHITUP TANG off slowly, trailed well back, passed tiring rivals while never a threat. MAUK'S TRIBUTE set the early pace, vied the middle four furlongs, gave way. SPENDARIDGE also tired from early efforts. SUPER HALO pressured the pace, gave way in traffic turning for home.
