Footnotes

TEMPT outrun in the early going, advanced four wide through the turn, challenged nearing the furlong marker, dug in late to prevail in game fashion. GLENDA'S MAHALO back off the pace inside, closer into the lane, split foes in some traffic midstretch, late bid inside the winner, outfinished. SUNRISE STAR not far back early, edged closer and slipped through along the rail to take over into the stretch, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, could not last. HONOUR ROCKET forwardly placed in the second flight early, fell back three wide in the turn, went evenly through the lane while improving slightly. KNIGHT OF HONOR bumped at the start, was forwardly placed in some traffic in the second flight early, weakened. A ROSE FOR SKYE bumped at the start, recovered to set the pace off the inside for a half, gave way when headed turning for home. MACABE'S GOLD last to leave, was never involved. FLATTITUDE was outrun while racing wide.
