JOEY THE SCHOLAR forwardly placed early from along the inside, moved a bit closer second turn, took advantage of an opening along the rail turning for home, scooted through, quickly clear, kept to pressure. QUE PASO settled off the pace, saved ground, also advanced along the inside turning for home to follow the winner, finished up willingly to be well clear for the place. B'WANAGOLDMINE off the pace while racing outside, came three wide into the lane, flattened out the final furlong, just held the show. SMILEY PETE closest to the leader, rated, continued in hand while between rivals into the lane, regained some position late, missed the show while once again between horses. K ONE FOUR off the pace, came three wide, into the out of the final turn, lacked a serious late kick while remaining widest of the second flight at the wire. RUN BRICK RUN broke on top, got clear, set the pace while off the inside, allowed both the winner and the runner up the inside into the lane, weakened in the drive. WAJIR ON ME void of speed, came four wide out of the final, turn, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a threat. INVISIBLE FORCE was never a threat. DREYFUS had nothing for the drive.
