SKIPAWAYWITHPAT raced behind the pace along the inside under restraint, eased out for room turning for home, challenged the leader inside the furlong grounds and proved best under steady handling. SORCERER'S URGE took control after the start, vied through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch, could not contain the winner, remained comfortably clear for the place. ONDA FAST TRACK lacked speed, raced five wide out of the turn, staged a mild rally out in the strip and was along for the show. CATHERINE'S LADY void of early foot, saved ground through the turn, improved position up the rail. FAVRETTE prompted the early pace off the inside, vied between rivals through the turn, weakened in the drive. TOUGH MOUNTAIN broke to the outside, raced four out to five wide turn, within striking distance a quarter out, came up empty for the drive. BARELA K broke out, pressured the early pace, four wide when forcing the issue late in the turn, retreated through the stretch. CANDI'S KITTEN steadily faded. IT'S A TALE last to leave, trailed while showing little.
